He is an experienced EMS, EMT and has been active for nearly 20 years in the field of crisis intervention and -management as team- leader, director and trainer. He is an international well trained specialist on traumacounselling, crisisintervention, crisis- and threatmanagement. Currently he is an executive traumacoach, trainer and consultant. He provides EAP, psychotherapy services, critical incident stress, trauma coaching and crisis management services for church organizations, communities, schools, NGO's, EMS, law enforcement, chaplaincy, and commercial. He is an expert adviser for different organizations providing crisis-intervention teams and crisismanagement system and an wellknown national and international trainer and speaker f.i. at "World Congress on Stress trauma and coping". Frank is an ICISF (International-Critical-Incident-Stress-Foundation) approved instructor. He gave Crisis support in the Eschede train disaster, the Flood in 2002 in East-Germany, 9/11 and the Tsunami disaster, als the Erfurt and Winnenden school-shooting and recently at the "Loveparade disaster". In the last years he is very involved in implementing a threefold stressprevention concept with crisisteam and crisispolicies in schools, to deal with incidents like school-shootings. He is part of the board of directors from the organization "SINUS-Supporting schools in crisis" which hold up a nationwide network giving support and training for schools and organizations or departments of education, schoolpsychologist and schoolsocialworkers. Support is also given to other schools and organizations of education in other European countries.
